The Facts

What We bring:

- Tent (geodesic dome, see pictures) to host:
 - Workshop Space with activity schedule
 - Chillout space
 - Bar for tea, healthy snacks, & non-alcoholic drinks
- Crew of teachers (acroyoga, contact impro, thai massage, speakers etc.)
- A sound system

What We Need:

- Level circular floor space for our dome: (12m diameter)
- Access to water to cook tea and clean dishes
- Electricity for cooker, light, sound (220V)

Good to know:

- Our preference is a somewhat quiet spot on the site or on the camp grounds
- It works best to have a grassy floor soft enough for anchor pegs to secure the tent-structure, in case of a concrete floor we can use loading plates as well.
